

Carry-on baggage limits to all destinations

Maximum 2 carry-on baggage

The following are examples of items counted as carry-on baggage. Travellers should consult their airline for dimensions.



What else can I bring?

Any of the following:

- small purses no bigger than 25 cm x 30 cm x 14 cm (10 in. x 12 in. x 5.5 in.)
- cameras (both still and video) in bags that contain no other items
- medication or medical equipment (oxygen tank, doctor's bag)
- coats and outer garments
- crutches
- canes
- walkers
- containers carrying life-sustaining items
- special needs items
- diplomatic or consular bags
- strollers and child restraint systems
- all duty-free items purchased after the security check



Personal Items

Items such as reading material and personal electronics should be stored in the passenger's carry-on bag, and packed prior to the security check. In general, having fewer carry-on items speeds the screening process for everyone.
